Interested in a career in museums?

Museums Galleries Scotland is looking for 22 motivated and enthusiastic learners to undertake a one-year paid placement in a host museum while studying for a nationally recognised qualification: **SVQ3**Museums & Galleries Practice. You will receive a £15,000 bursary, have access to a professional mentor and will be fully supported throughout your placement.

Scotland's national body for museum development runs vocational programmes to provide an alternative route of entry into the museums sector for non-graduates from diverse backgrounds. For *Skills for Success*, we are delighted to have the support of the *Heritage Lottery Fund*.

Skills for Success will teach eighteen entry-level and four management-level non-graduates the nuts and bolts of the museums world, such as collections care, digitisation, fundraising, marketing, learning programmes and volunteer management.

The prospects look great too: **87%** of our learners have gone on to find employment after training, with roles including Museum Managers, Curators, Collections Assistants and Learning Managers.

Interested in getting involved in this fascinating and vibrant world of work? Learner recruitment will begin April 2018 with a start date of August/September 2018.
