### 1. Give the Car a Rest:

With a little bit of forward planning our best sights and visitor attractions are accessible by public transport; some are very close by and can be easily reached on foot. ### 2. Shop Local and Support Green Businesses:

We work hard to source locally produced, ethical and environmentally responsible products so that you can visit, shop, eat and drink at The Scottish Crannog Centre knowing that you are having a positive impact on our community, landscape and wider environment. ### 3. Reduce, Reuse and Recycle:

You can help us in our efforts to reduce, reuse and recycle waste at the Scottish Crannog Centre. We provide separate bins for food waste, dry mixed recycling and general waste. Please read the lists provided on the bins to find the right bin for your rubbish and don't hesitate to ask for help from our team: we are happy to wash out your yogurt pot so that it can be recycled or to advise you where to put your banana skin! We try to keep packaging to a minimum in our shop; we reuse bubble wrap and other packing materials and will never assume that you want a carrier bag but are very happy to wrap delicate items for you - just let us know how we can help!

#### **4. Conserve Energy and Water:**

We are working to reduce our energy and water usage and you can help us by switching off lights when you leave the toilets and by being careful not to leave taps running.

#### **5. Respect Nature:**

We occupy a beautiful location on the banks of Loch Tay; you can help us to look after the landscape and wildlife by not littering, guarding against fire and using roads, footpaths and cycle ways responsibly.
